Share your experience - help improve services - Emotional Touchpoints

Helensburgh and Lomond Carers Centre have joined with the Health and Social Care Partnership to find out about people's experience of local services.

Pamela has been trained to interview people using the Emotional Touchpoints. This is a new toolkit for interviewing people and is designed to capture the individual's experience of the service.

The programme of interviews is funded by the Helensburgh and Lomond Integrated Care Fund – this fund is an allocation from Scottish Government to help Health and Social Care Partnerships work effectively together with local providers, third sector organisations and communities to improve services.

The aim of the interviews is for people who are receiving services and their carers to share their experiences of what is good about services and importantly how services could be better. Local health and social care staff will use the information from the interviews to demonstrate the positive impact of community care services in keeping people at home and to improve services where possible.

If you have recently been in receipt of a service from health, social care or the carer's centre Pamela would be interested to hear your experience. If you are interested in taking part, please call Pamela and she will be able to answer any questions you have about this before you make a decision about going ahead with the interview.
