Banana Bread

INGREDIENTS

4 bananas 285g Plain Flour 225g Caster Sugar 110g Margarine 1/2 tsp salt



1/2 tsp Bicarbonate of Soda

Cooking time: 60 mins

Prep: 10 mins

Serves: 1 loaf size tin

METHOD

- Mash bananas
- Mix the margarine & sugar together then add to bananas
- 3. Sieve the flour, bicarbonate of soda and salt into the mix and stir well (add a little milk if needed)
