Budget 2012 - Key Announcements

George Osborne's third Budget "rewards work" and "unashamedly backs business", he told MPs last week. He promised to deliver a "simpler tax system" that would be more competitive, to help lift low-paid workers out of paying tax and to increase the amount of money the Treasury gets from the rich.

Some of the main changes include: the 50p top rate of income tax will be cut to 45p and the salary at which child benefit will be withdrawn will be increased. New stamp duty measures will see properties sold for more than £2m subject to a new 7 per cent stamp duty charge.

There were also several important welfare reforms mentioned: there will be an automatic review of the state pension age. A single tier pension, at a minimum of £140, will be set. Age-related tax allowances for pensioners will be simplified. Child benefit to be reduced incrementally when one member of household earns more than £50,000. Child benefit will be removed completely at £60,000. Up to £10bn additional welfare savings will be needed by 2016!
